

Implementation, Information Systems, Communication and Coordination Task Group

The South East Queensland Regional Water Supply Strategy is now in its second stage. Strategy task groups are examining a range of water issues in the SEQ region. A draft SEQ Regional Water Supply Strategy will be considered by the State Government in late 2006.

One of the six task groups is the Implementation, Information Systems, Communication and Coordination (IICC) Task Group. The IICC task group plays a major support role in the SEQ Regional Water Supply Strategy. Work being undertaken by this group is critical to securing a sustainable water future for the region.

The four key roles assigned to the IICC are:

- **Administering** the SEQ Regional Water Supply Strategy and ensuring task groups, consultants and their budgets are properly managed.
- **Delivering** the communication between all stakeholders and the public about the Strategy, ensuring the whole community is aware of the shared responsibilities and benefits of proper water planning in south east Queensland.
- **Managing** the data and information used and generated during the development of the Strategy.
- **Planning** for the eventual implementation of the Strategy.
